

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) between

Burlington Community School District's PiECES program

and

Eagle View Community Health Center, Inc.

This is an agreement between "Program", hereinafter called BCSD PiECES and "Partner", hereinafter called Eagle View.

I. PURPOSE & SCOPE

The purpose of this MOU is to clearly identify the roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to partnership with the BCSD PiECES after school program.

In particular, this MOU is intended to:

- » Expand access to programming for more youth and their families within the BCSD PiECES program
- » Enhance students' and family learning through enrichment offered by our community partner
- » Expand opportunities for the youth and families of BCSD PiECES program to participate in activities and events held by the partner

II. BACKGROUND

Eagle View Community Health System, Inc. is a not-for-profit provider of community health care services (dental, medical, and behavioral health) with a location as a school based health clinic (SBHC) in Burlington High School. Eagle View has operated their main clinic in Oquawka, IL since 1979, a clinic in Stronghurst, IL since 2000, and the SBHC at BHS since 2021.

Eagle View's partnership with BCSD as a SBHC began in 2021 as a need for health, dental, and behavioral health services was profound throughout the District. Eagle View will provide a variety of services including primary medical care, immunizations, behavioral health care, pediatric care, women's health, and ongoing health education for our students and families.

As a SBHC, Eagle View will operate out of a clinic at Burlington High School (BHS) but will be serving the families and students attending any BCSD school and all staff of BCSD. These extend to the BCSD PiECES program.

III. PROGRAM RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS MOU

BCSD PiECES shall undertake the following activities:

- Support the staff from Eagle View's program when they provide enrichment and health education; programming to PiECES students and/or family members;
- Promote Eagle View and the SBHC programs and events to the students and families of PiECES;

- Secure program time during the PiECES program hours for any Eagle View staff to engage with PiECES students and families;
- Invite Eagle View to all YouthNet/PiECES Advisory Council meetings held on a monthly basis.

IV. PARTNER RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS MOU

Eagle View shall undertake the following activities:

- Outreach visits to the after school program and the families of BCSD PiECES programs;
- Work with school staff to partner on activities offered by Eagle View;
- Provide medical and behavioral health enrichment and educational content or programming activities to the students and families of BCSD PiECES programs;
- Coordinate activities with BCSD for students and families in collaboration with family engagement or family literacy programing for PiECES.



V. FUNDING
